- Improvement on Educational Efficiency.

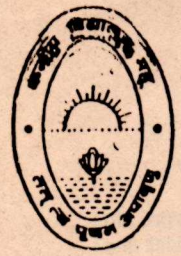


